MAIN POINTS & SCRIPTURES

We have taken this year to go back to the basics and become rooted in Jesus, so we can flourish in life. **(Colossians 2:6-7, Ephesians 3:17-20)**

A tree's roots draw the nourishment it needs from being rooted in the soil. Our roots draw the truth of God into our lives. The soils represent the ways of God and the roots represent the paths with which we draw God's ways into our lives. **(Psalm 25:4, 1 Corinthians 1:18, Matthew 4:19)**

We know we're becoming rooted in Jesus when we experience:

- a) Growing in the fruit of the Spirit. **(Galatians 5:22-23)**
- b) Growing in our love for God. **(Mark 12:30, 1 John 4:19)**
- c) Growing in our love for people. **(John 13:34-35, Matthew 28:19-20)**
- d) Growing in our generosity. **(Matthew 10:8)**
- e) Growing in our obedience. **(Titus 2:12, John 14:15)**

KEY VERSE

So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in Him, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

Colossians 2:6-7



POTENTIAL NEXT STEP
