SUMMARY

The world tries to put limits on us. Whether it's age, gender, or our past, we are constantly having limits put on us. Jesus offers us a another option. John 10:10 says *"I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."* In other words, Jesus wants us to have a LIMITLESS life. We can push past all those limits by doing three things.

1. **Realizing we need a supernatural source of power.** In John 14:16-17 Jesus tells us that He sent the Holy Spirit to live inside of us, He will give us power, and that we will know Him intimately.
2. **Having a small group of people in our lives.** Like Paul and Silas when Jason was jumped in Acts 17:6.
3. **Continuing to say "Yes" to Jesus.** Revelation 3:20 says "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me." Jesus is always inviting us to experience more of His goodness, His peace, and His freedom. When we say "Yes" to Jesus we are following Him towards what He has for us and it's always better than what He is inviting us to step out of.

This week let's push past our limits and experience the LIMITLESS life Jesus has for us by applying these three things daily!

QUESTIONS

1. What has been limiting you?
2. Jesus wants you to have a LIMITLESS life. Talk about what causes you to doubt that and how you can take a step in believing that is truth.
3. Acts 1:8 says you receive power from the Holy Spirit. Do you believe that? What about when you don't FEEL it?
4. Who's your small group of people that push you and encourage you?
5. Jesus has more of the limitless life for us. We find it by continuing to say "Yes" to Jesus. What is Jesus asking you to say "Yes" to?
